DNA EVIDENCE

The following items of evidence were received from Evidence Control on October 27, 2016. Senior Criminalist Terry Evans extracted the DNA from the samples. Senior Criminalist Erica Estrada received the extracted DNA on October 31, 2016 for the purpose of DNA typing.

Item 1: Swabs from Stephen Reynolds' Randy Johnson's jacket

Item 2: Swabs from the front driver-side exterior door of Stephen Reynolds' **Randy Johnson's** car.

DNA ANALYSIS

The extracted deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) from the above samples was amplified using the Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) and analyzed using capillary electrophoresis.

Item 1: Swabs from Randy Johnson's jacket

The swab from Randy Johnson's jacket yielded a mixture of two or more DNA sources. One DNA profile is consistent with Randy Johnson. No definitive conclusion regarding the identity of the secondary contributor can be made. Stephen Reynolds is a possible source of the secondary contributor. It is 200 times more likely that the mixture is a result of DNA from Randy Johnson and Stephen Reynolds than if it originated from Randy Johnson and an unrelated population.

Item 2: Swabs from the front driver-side exterior door of Randy Johnson's car

The swabs from the exterior door yielded DNA results yielded a mixture of two or more individuals. This profile can be separated into a major male contributor profile and one or more minor contributors. Randy Johnson is the source of the major male contributor profile, and Stephen Reynolds is the source of a secondary male contributor profile.
